



ROAD CLOSURE INFORMATION

SUNDAY 17TH OCTOBER

On the weekend of Saturday 16th and Sunday 17th October there will be some changes to usual traffic routes in Oxford, due to the Oxford Half Marathon. The full list of roads to be closed can be found below, along with their latest reopening times. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times on all roads.

On Saturday 16th, Broad Street (between Turl St & Magdalen St East) will close at 08:00. At 18:00 the remainder of Broad Street, along with Parks Road (between Holywell St & South Parks Rd) and a small section of Museum Road will close. These roads will remain closed on Sunday 17th and reopen no later than 18:00. Parking suspensions will be in place throughout this period on Broad Street, Parks Road and Museum Road.

All additional roads listed below close at 08:00 on Sunday 17th, with the exception of Holywell Street which closes at 06:00. Parking suspensions will be in place on all roads marked with

Please note, residents in the Norham Manor (NM) CPZ will be permitted to park their vehicles in roads on the west of Banbury Road, in either the Walton Manor (WM) or North Oxford (NX) CPZs, from Saturday 16th evening through until Sunday 17th evening. This will enable vehicle access out of the area during the road closure period.

In addition to the above closures some roads adjoining the race route will experience restricted access. Please check the map and details of access points overleaf. For access throughout the closure period, use Jackson Road to travel between the Sunnymead & Cutteslowe estates and the A40/Elsfield Way.

B

One way access from:

- Diamond Place to Thorncliffe Road
- Oakthorpe Road to Diamond Place

Access point open from:

08:00 – 09:15

11:45 onwards

Banbury Road (between A40 and Marston Ferry Road) reopens no later than 12:00

Access in both directions from Oxford Road, into Old Marston

Access point open from:

08:00 – 09:30

12:15 onwards

Oxford Road reopens no later than 13:00

Access between:

Horseman Close and Marsh Lane – southbound travel only

12:15 onwards

Marsh Lane reopens no later than 13:00

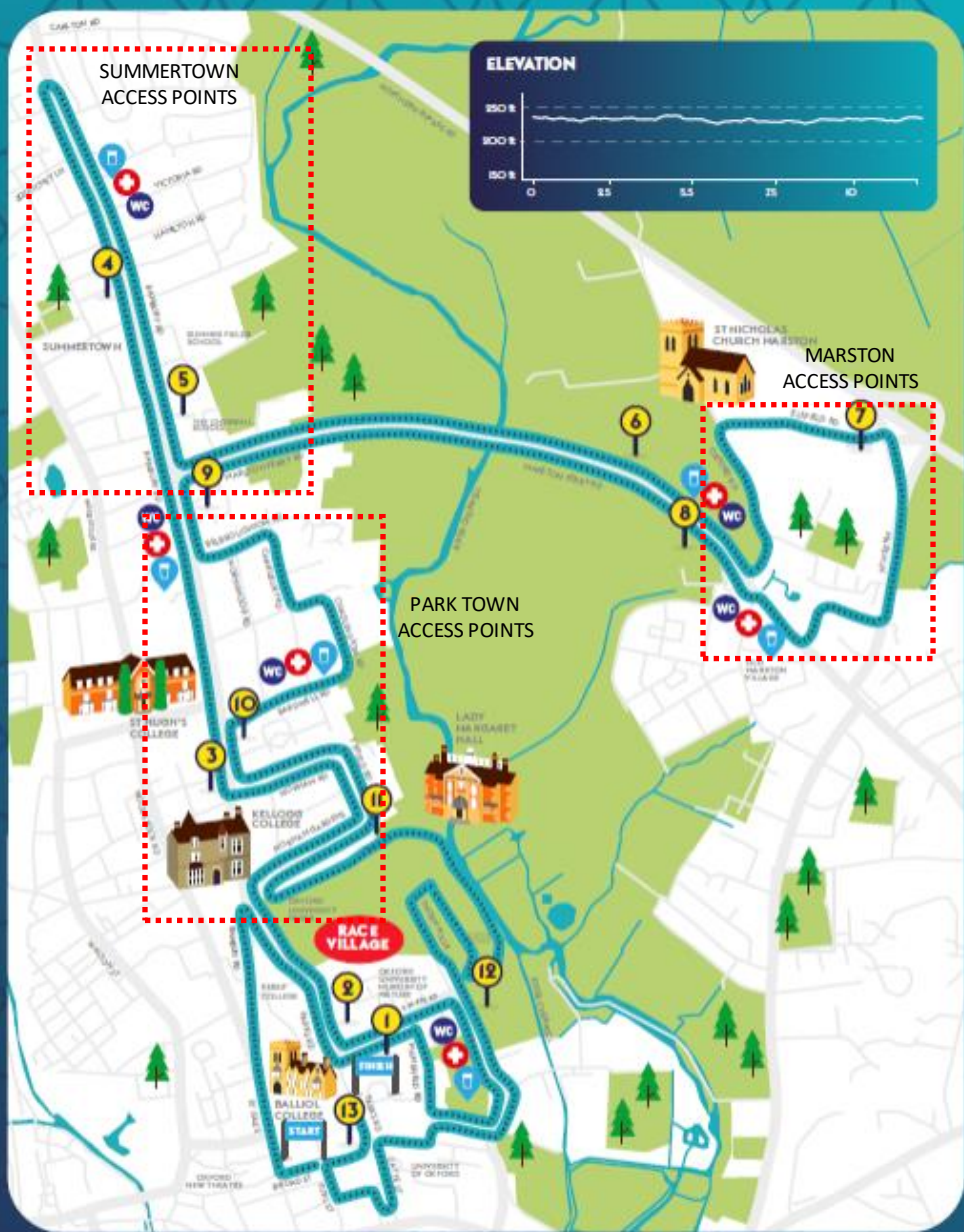
Access at all times in both directions,

CITY CENTRE DIVERSION

From 08:00 on Sunday

clearly signed diversion will be

Road (A490), Abingdon Road
(A4144), Donnington Bridge
